



Description: Assessment Task 1
Task type & mode: Listening, Test conditions
Task weighting: 30%
Diverse Perspectives, 2023-S2, Week 6

Criteria

Achievement standards targeted for BSSS Modern Languages courses 2020-2024 come under the following two fields: understanding and communicating.

The listening assessment task focuses on the first of these domains: **understanding**. This task will assess your **understanding and analytical skills**, which will be equally weighted in the marking scheme. You will need to demonstrate your understanding of what you hear and provide a coherent analytical response to stimulus texts. Marking will not be based on grammar or spelling, provided that the expression is understandable for a native speaker of the target language. However, you will receive some advice about your written expression that may be useful to you for the writing tests.

Preparation

You should review the resources during the first half of the semester (Q3). Refer to the term overview and unit outline for information about topics and domains. Assessment task structure

This task will provide you with the opportunity to demonstrate your comprehension by asking you questions about a range of audio sources in your target language. The sources will be related to the topic focus areas and connected domains listed on your class page on Language.Org.Au. They are also listed in the class overview for this semester, available via a link from the class page.

Your responses must be entirely your own work. No translation apps or devices are permitted.
