



## Description: Assessment Task 3

Task type & mode: Speaking – Test conditions

Task weighting: 30%

### Assessment Criteria

Assessment criteria for ACT senior secondary courses in Modern Languages relate to understanding and communication. For the speaking task, the focus is the second of these areas: communication.

This assessment task is about showing your ability to speak in a coherent and well-informed manner about an area selected from the topics below and demonstrating your language repertoire (vocabulary, grammar, pronunciation, oral expression) by participating in an informative discussion about these subjects.

For the marking scheme to be used in this task, please refer to the assessment rubric.

### Preparation

For this assessment task, you will discuss one of the topics covered during the second half of semester (Q4). Refer to the term overview and unit outline for information about topics and domains. See also the topic focus areas on your class page on Languages.Org.Au, and your class portal for this semester on Google Classroom, for further details. Please nominate your proposed topic focus area in Week 12.

### Task session

In your class group, the teacher will facilitate student discussion of topics related to the unit theme covered in class (listed under “Theme” below). You will be asked to briefly introduce your topic (at most, one-third of the allotted time) before discussing it with your teacher and/or responding to questions from other students.
